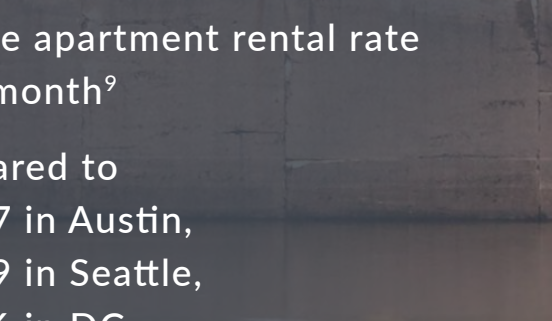
## VENTURE CAPITAL

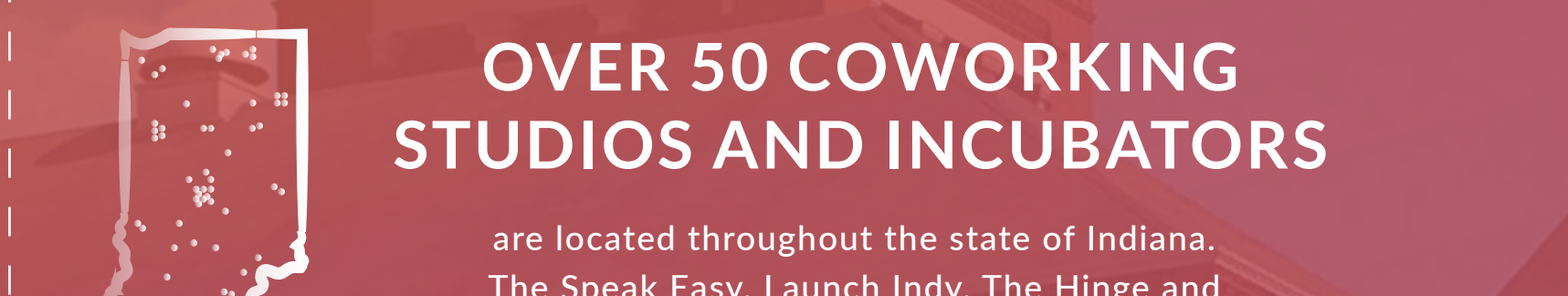

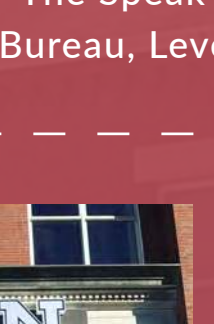

Salesforce's CEO and Chairman Marc Benioff celebrated the grand opening of Salesforce Tower, the tallest building in the state of Indiana.



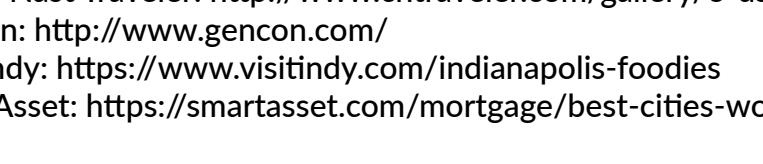
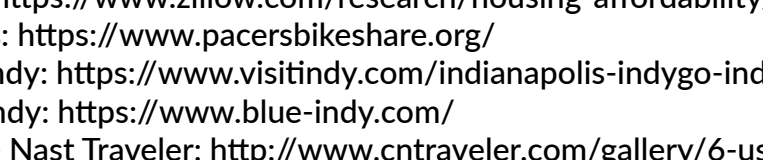
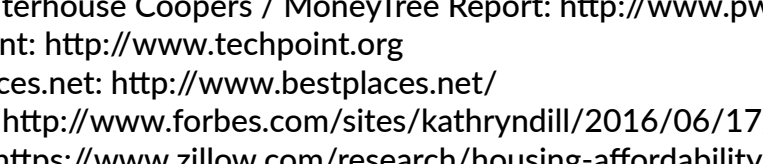
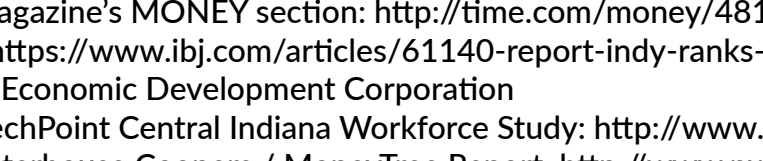
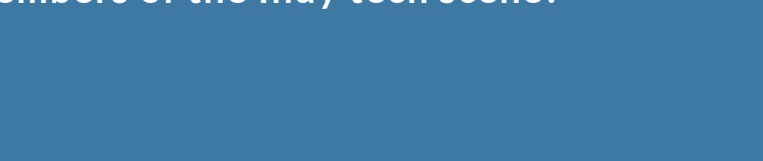
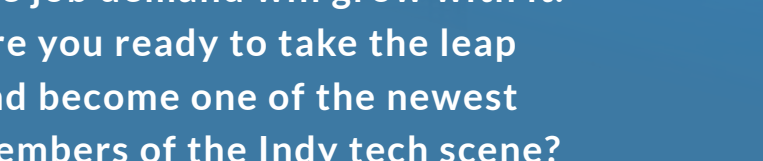
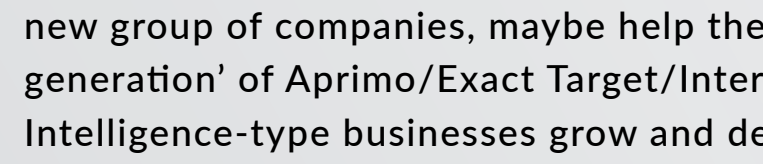
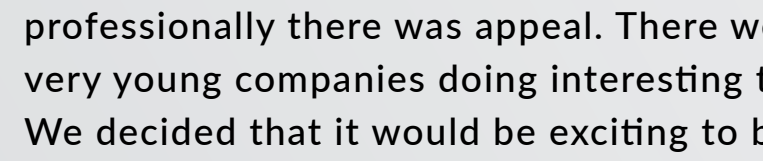
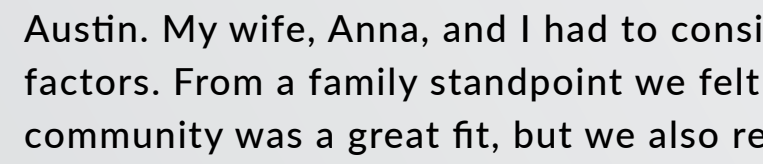
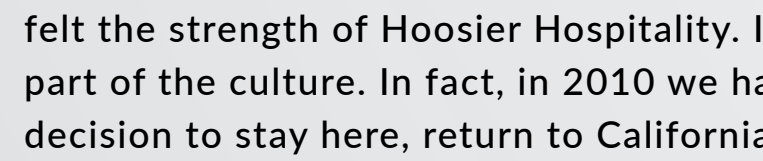
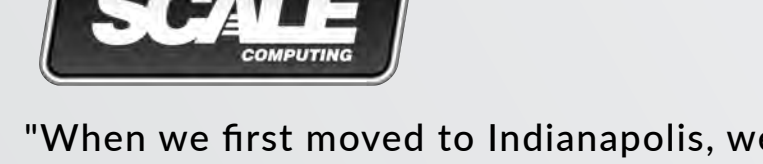
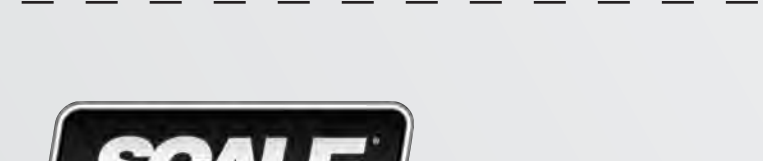
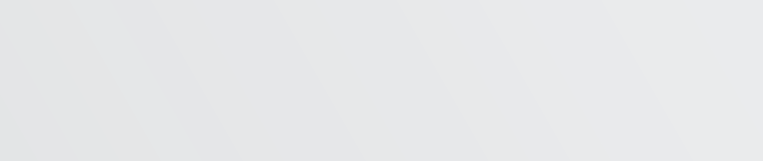
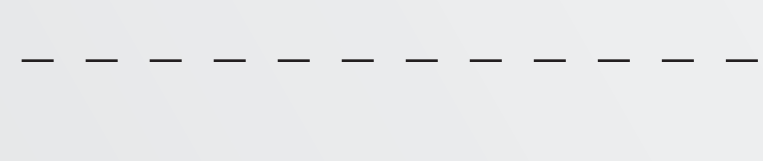
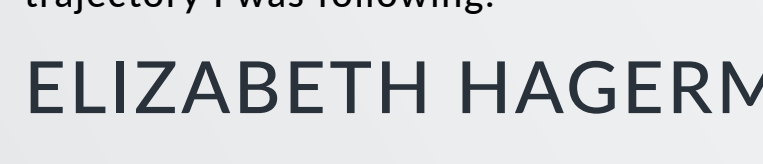
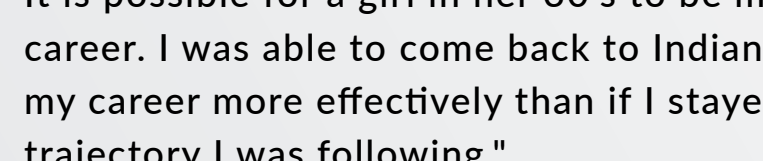
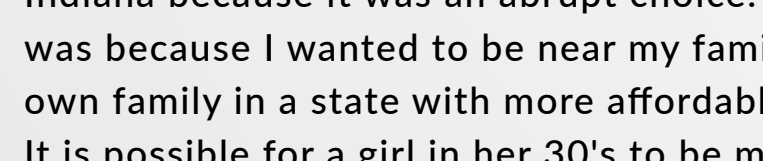
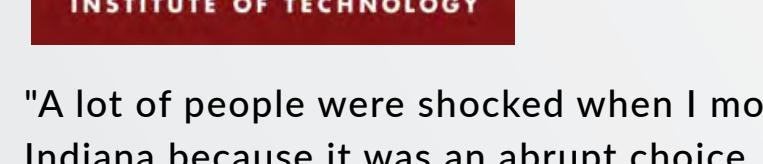
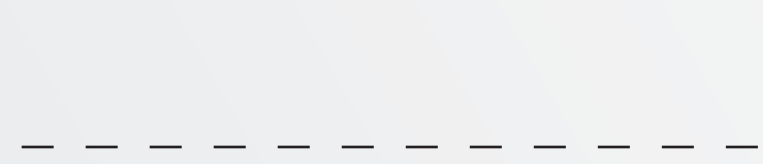
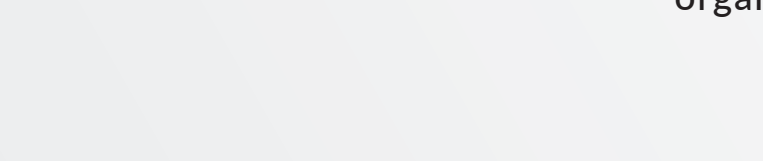
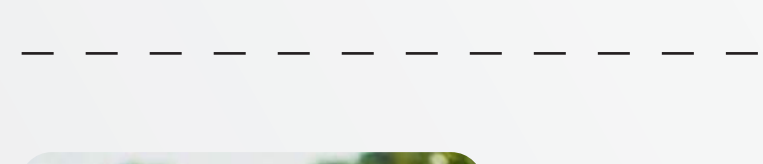
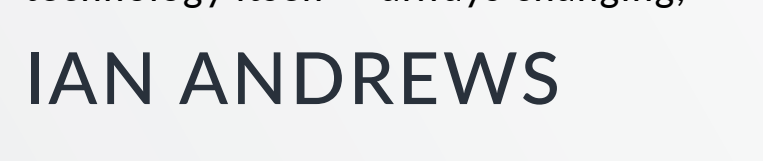
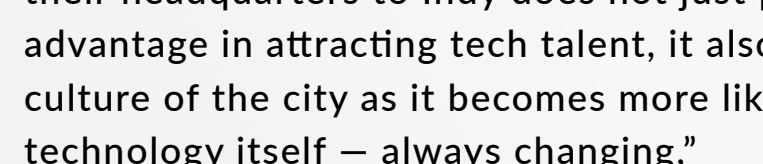
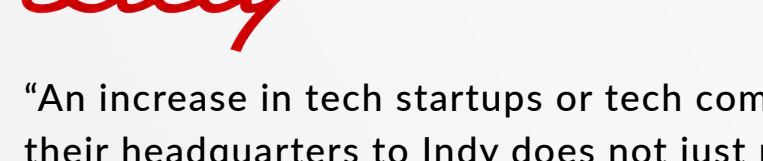
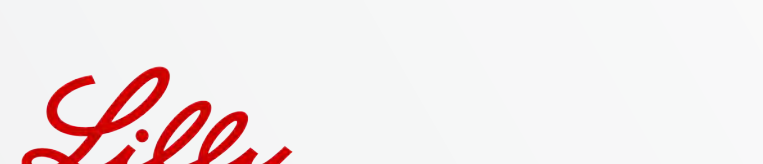
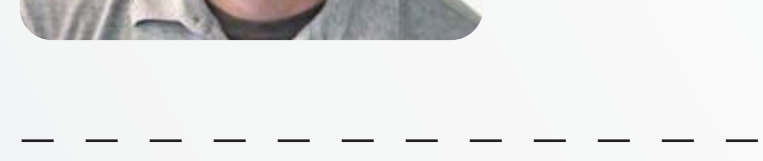
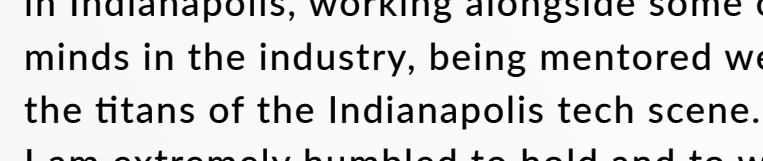
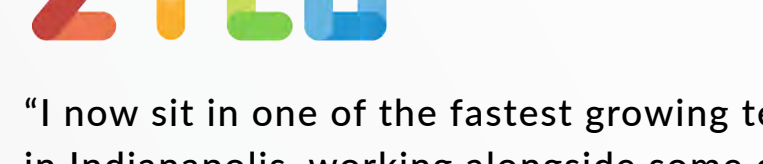
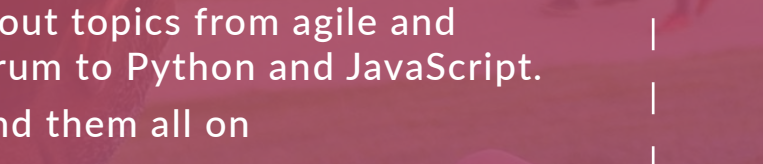
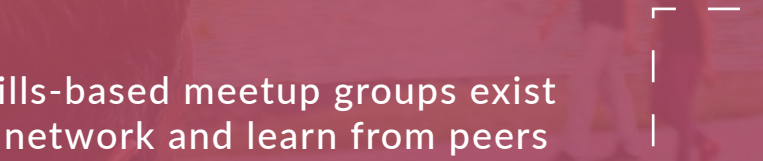
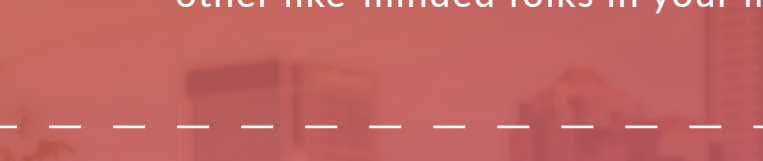
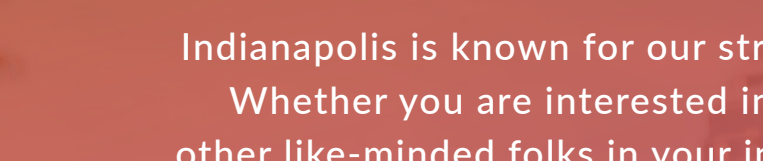
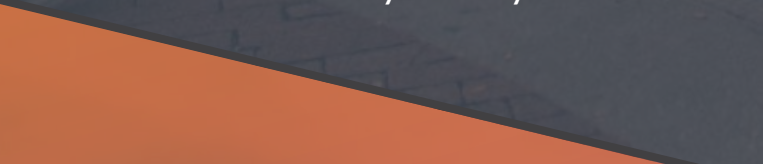
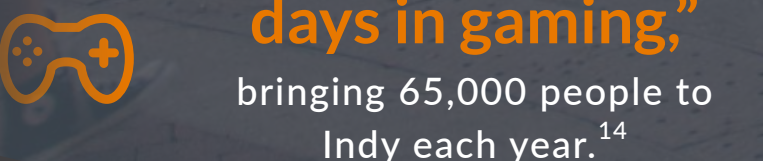
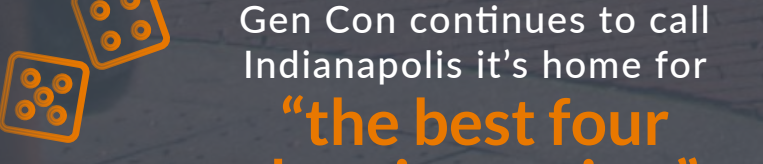
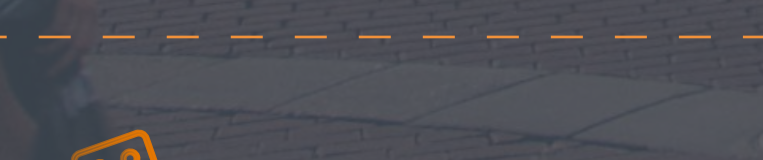
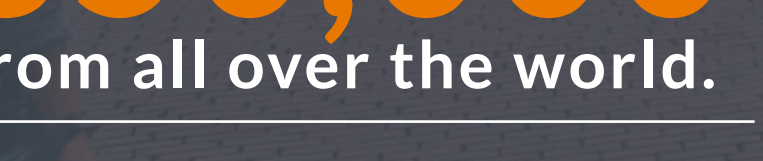
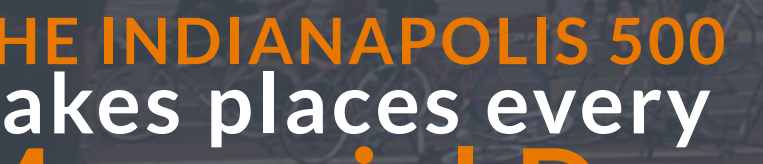
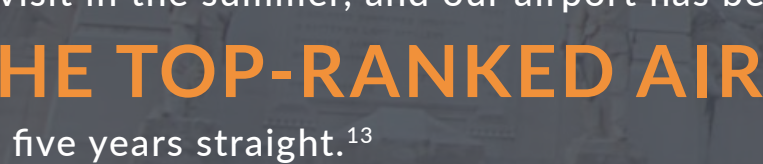
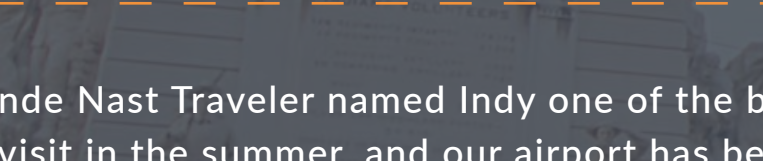
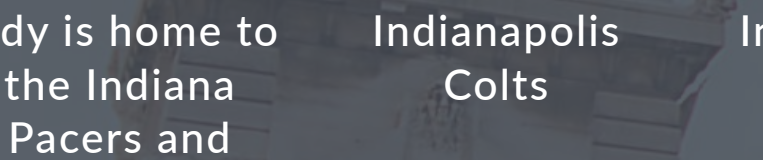
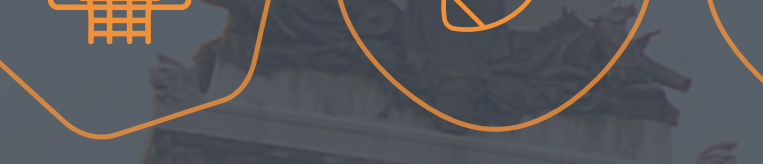
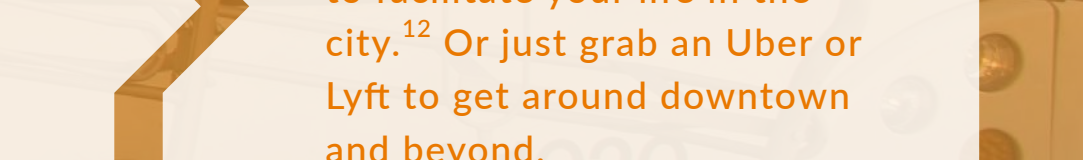
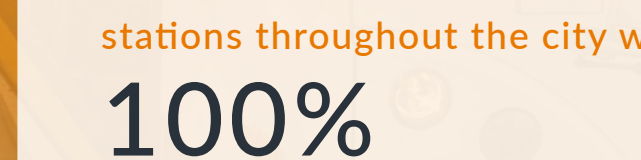
